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POLITE REQUEST It is lovely to see so many parents gathering in the school playground before and after school. Could parents please move further into the playground to avoid congestion at the gate. Children are struggling to get past with bags, bikes, scooters, musical instruments etc. Parents are also finding it difficult to get past with buggies. The staff car park is **NOT** a designated pupil entrance to the playground and is not safe for pupils to use as cars are moving in and out of the car park at the beginning and end of the day.
