If you would like to become part of a forward thinking Parent Council, who will be actively involved in taking St Mary's forward and being involved in the decision making process about a new school, then come along to the meeting to find out more.

We need to elect new Office Bearers and Parent representatives for each class in the school. Please think about putting yourself forward – the school needs you!

PLEASE NOTE Any money to be handed in to school should be given to your child to be recorded against the class cash sheet at registration time. All money should be in an envelope with your child's name, class and reason for payment clearly labelled. Please avoid handing money into the School Office.

<u>ALL MEDICATION MUST</u> be handed in to the school office and the appropriate medical form completed. Please do not ever give your child medication to bring to school in their bag. Pupils requiring inhalers need to have two in school – one in class and one at the school office. Please check expiry dates on medication such as epi pens and inhalers.

SCHOOL MEALS are now £1.90. Cash can be sent in each day in a named envelope or purse -

change is given. Or you can send in the amount for the week and we will hold this in school for use each day.

CHILDREN WHO ARE ABSENT FROM SCHOOL 0131 271 4690

If your child is absent from school – including Nursery - for whatever reason it is <u>your</u> responsibility to inform the school. The school answering service is available for early morning calls, and if possible please phone the school before 9am to report a pupil absence. Please state clearly the name of the child, which class, and the reason for absence. Please also collect your children promptly and telephone the school if you are running late.

If your child is not at school and we have not had a phone call our Child Protection Procedures are followed to ensure your child is safe. Please ensure that the school has up to date contact details especially if your mobile phone is the main mode of contact. The SMS Text service will be used in the first instance to make contact with you. Where parents cannot be contacted and fail to return calls I will inform the Children and Families Team of repeated absences.

Please remember that we only make a call like this because you have not phoned the school in the first instance, and to ensure that your child is safe. Please be courteous to staff when this happens as we are only doing our jobs and acting in the best interests of your child.

Please also try to ensure that your child is on time for school at 9am. Your child misses important information at the start of the day and it is disruptive to the class and embarrassing for them.

On a very wet morning I will open the door to the gym hall for children to gather from 8.50am.
