We already have a number of children arriving late for school and a number of unexplained absences. Pleasse follow the procedure below to inform school of absence and help your child to arrive at school on time

**PLEASE NOTE** Any money to be handed in to school should be given to your child to be recorded against the class cash sheet at registration time. All money should be in an envelope with your child's name, class and reason for payment clearly labelled. Please avoid handing money into the School Office.

<u>ALL MEDICATION MUST</u> be handed in to the school office and the appropriate medical form completed. Please do not ever give your child medication to bring to school in their bag. Pupils requiring inhalers need to have two in school – one in class and one at the school office. Please check expiry dates on medication such as epi pens and inhalers.

**SCHOOL MEALS** are now £1.90. Cash can be sent in each day in a named envelope or purse – change is given. Or you can send in the amount for the week and we will hold this in school for use each day.

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As you will see from the School Calendar, classes are involved in a number of activities that take them out of school. We can only participate in these events if we have the support of parent helpers to escort the children. We have had a number of parents who have volunteered to help with any class but we still need more. If you are willing to be asked to volunteer (sometimes you might not be able to), please let the School Office know so that they can contact you.

Thanks to everyone who returned the Seemis update forms promptly – hundreds of extra house points have been given out. Please remember to provide a NAMED, waterproof jacket each day for school. I will open the side door to the gym hall at 8.50am in the event of very heavy rain. Children will still go out to play in light rain so jackets are essential.

**POLITE REQUESTS** It is lovely to see so many parents gathering in the school playground before and after school. Could parents please move further into the playground to avoid congestion at the gate. Children are struggling to get past with bags, bikes, scooters, musical instruments etc. Parents are also finding it difficult to get past with buggies. Bikes and scooters should be placed on the racks as soon as pupils arrive at school.

Please supervise your child entering the playground from the car park as we have already had a few near misses.

Please note that dogs are not permitted in any Midlothian Council School Playground and I would ask that if you are waiting outside the gates with a dog that you move further back from the entrance, as a number of children are afraid to pass dogs on the pavement.

If you need to speak to your child's teacher please arrange to do this after school and not first thing after the bell has gone as the children need to be escorted into school. Could parents please stand back from the lines in the morning so that the children can line up quickly, especially P3/4 -P7, where the lines are very long.

We have a number of children who are not being collected on time from Nursery and school at the end of the day. Please be on time. Staff have additional planning, preparation and training to do after the children are dismissed. Your cooperation with this is greatly appreciated.

Please take time this weekend to check that all school uniform, bags, lunch boxes etc are clearly NAMED. Our lost property boxes are already overflowing with unnamed items!

Please try to support us as a Health Promoting School by only sending in a bottle of water each day and a healthy snack such as fruit/yogurt tubes etc. Items containing nuts are not permitted for snack or packed lunch - this includes peanut butter spread and hazelnut spread. We have a number of pupils with nut allergies in school.
