Dear Parents and Carers

These are the final arrangements for our P7 pupils who are attending School Camp.

As the cost of the bus was less than we expected we have held on to the £4.79 as your child's tuck money. No additional money is required now.

DEPARTURE: Children should arrive at school on Monday at their usual time and bring all luggage, medical forms etc to the packed lunch area where Miss Murphy and Mrs Macaulay will meet them to complete a final check in. Luggage will be labelled with our school ribbon which is orange and final checks of medication and paperwork will be made. Parents should say their goodbyes at this point. The children will require a **packed lunch** on Monday 29th April and lunches will be provided for those on Free School Meals. **The bus will leave from St Mary's at 12.20 pm.**

ARRIVAL: The children will depart from Lockerbie on Friday 3rd May at 1.30pm and arrive back at school **between 3.00 and 3.30pm.** They will have lunch at Manor Adventure before departing.

MEDICINE: Please complete the **Med 1 form** and **Appendix 14** which will allow us to administer medication to your child while at Camp. Please ensure that all medication is clearly labelled with your child's name. Your child should have **2 inhalers** at Camp, if they use them. All medication with completed forms inside sealed bag (freezer bag) should be brought to school **BY AN ADULT on Monday 29th April.**

CONTACT: Miss Murphy and I will be accompanying the children to Camp this year and will be in daily contact with the school. I will contact St Mary's on arrival at Camp and the school office will text you all with this news. Please do not contact Manor Adventure. Updates from Camp will be posted daily on the school website and twitter account .

IN AN EMERGENCY, should you need to contact your child urgently, please telephone the school on **0131 271 4690** during school hours and **07856 593 116** out of school hours. We will then contact Manor Adventure to pass on any urgent messages. I will contact the school and parents in the event of an emergency at the centre.

MOBILE PHONES AND DIGITAL CAMERAS
